Journalism and Cultural Anthropology, BA (Boston)

This combined major allows students to integrate theoretical perspectives and conceptual tools from cultural anthropology with their study and practice of journalism. The program offers them an opportunity to develop a deep understanding of both disciplines, allowing graduates to pursue writing projects and cover current events through an anthropological lens. The combined major offers flexibility so that students can study and write about the issues that most interest them.
