Health Science and Sociology, BS (Boston)

The combined Bachelor of Science in Health Science and Sociology integrates social scientific perspectives with the study of health, illness, and healthcare. Students explore basic sociological concepts relevant for the study of health and healthcare, such as social construction and medicalization. Students explore why, for instance, despite having the most expensive healthcare system, the United States ranks comparatively low in life expectancy and health and well-being outcomes. The combined major offers students an opportunity to explore the ways that societal factors such as race, class, and gender interplay with health, healthcare, and health disparities.
