

History, BA (New York)

The Bachelor of Arts is a broadly based liberal arts degree in history. Students who pursue the BA degree must satisfy general requirements and take courses to satisfy Northeastern's universitywide core curriculum (NUpath (<https://catalog.northeastern.edu/undergraduate/university-academics/nupath/>)), in addition to required and elective history courses. These requirements help students develop their historical knowledge and skills within the contexts of the arts, humanities, social sciences, and sciences that together comprise the disciplinary sources of historical knowledge. The curriculum enables historical understanding to be culturally and linguistically sensitive to the subjects of historical inquiry.

This program is currently only available to former Marymount Manhattan College students who are eligible for continued enrollment at Northeastern University. This program includes required courses that will be taught on ground at the Northeastern New York City campus.

Program Requirements
