The Bachelor of Arts in Human Services and Public Health is designed to prepare students to address health and social issues through an interdisciplinary approach grounded in prevention science. With a dual foundation in public health and human services, courses blend key theories, research, and skills from both fields to prepare graduates for fields in health education, advocacy, community well-being, case management, and social change. The curriculum provides students with data-driven strategies to understand and respond to social determinants of health in both communitybased settings and in public policy. Throughout the courses, service-learning, and experiential opportunities, students have an opportunity to develop core competencies such as counseling, curricula development and facilitation, program planning and development, policy analysis, and research methods.
