# Russian, Minor

The Russian minor focuses on two specific outcomes: developing students' linguistic proficiency and broadening their insights into Russian culture so that students may engage in meaningful interactions with Russian speakers throughout the world. The communication skills and transcultural awareness that students develop throughout the course of the minor are designed to prepare them for a wide range of opportunities and experiences, both in and beyond the classroom.

## **Minor Requirements**

Complete all courses as outlined below unless otherwise indicated. A total of **five courses** is required. A maximum of two transfer courses, including transferable courses taken abroad, may count toward the five courses required for the minor. Study-abroad courses must be approved by the Russian academic coordinator prior to the semester abroad.
